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Itchin' to be stitchin'
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Adventure Time Jake the Dog Pattern

Mathematical!

You'll need:

<50g DK yellow yarn (I used Special by Stylecraft DK 1081 Saffron); 3mm hook; 2 pipecleaners; black and white felt; toy stuffing; glue; yarn needle

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Stitches/abbreviations used

ch = chain

ss = slip stitch

sc = *single crochet*

inc = *increase (2 sc in one stitch)*

dec = *decrease (insert hook into front loops of next 2 stitches and sc them as one)*

blo = *back loops only*

At the end of each round, ss into the first sc of the round to join.

At the start of each round, ch 1 and start the round in the first sc of the previous round.

Head

We start at the top of Jake's head.

R1. sc 6 in a magic ring. (6)

R2. inc x 6. (12)

R3. *inc x 2, sc* x 4. (20)

R4. sc around. (20)

R5. *inc, sc x 3* x 5. (25)

R6. –R13. sc around. (25)

R14. *dec, sc x 3* x 5. (20)

R15. sc around. (20)

R16. *dec x 2, sc* x 4. (12) *Stuff – or you may wish to start the limbs first, read on...*

R17. dec x 6. (6) *Fasten off*

Muzzle

R1. ch12. (12)

R2. Starting in 2nd chain from hook: sc x 10, 4sc in last chain, sc x 3, dec x 2, sc x 3, ss in first sc. (23)

R3. In blo: sc x 15, dec x 2, sc x 4. (21)

Fasten off with a long tail to sew to the face.



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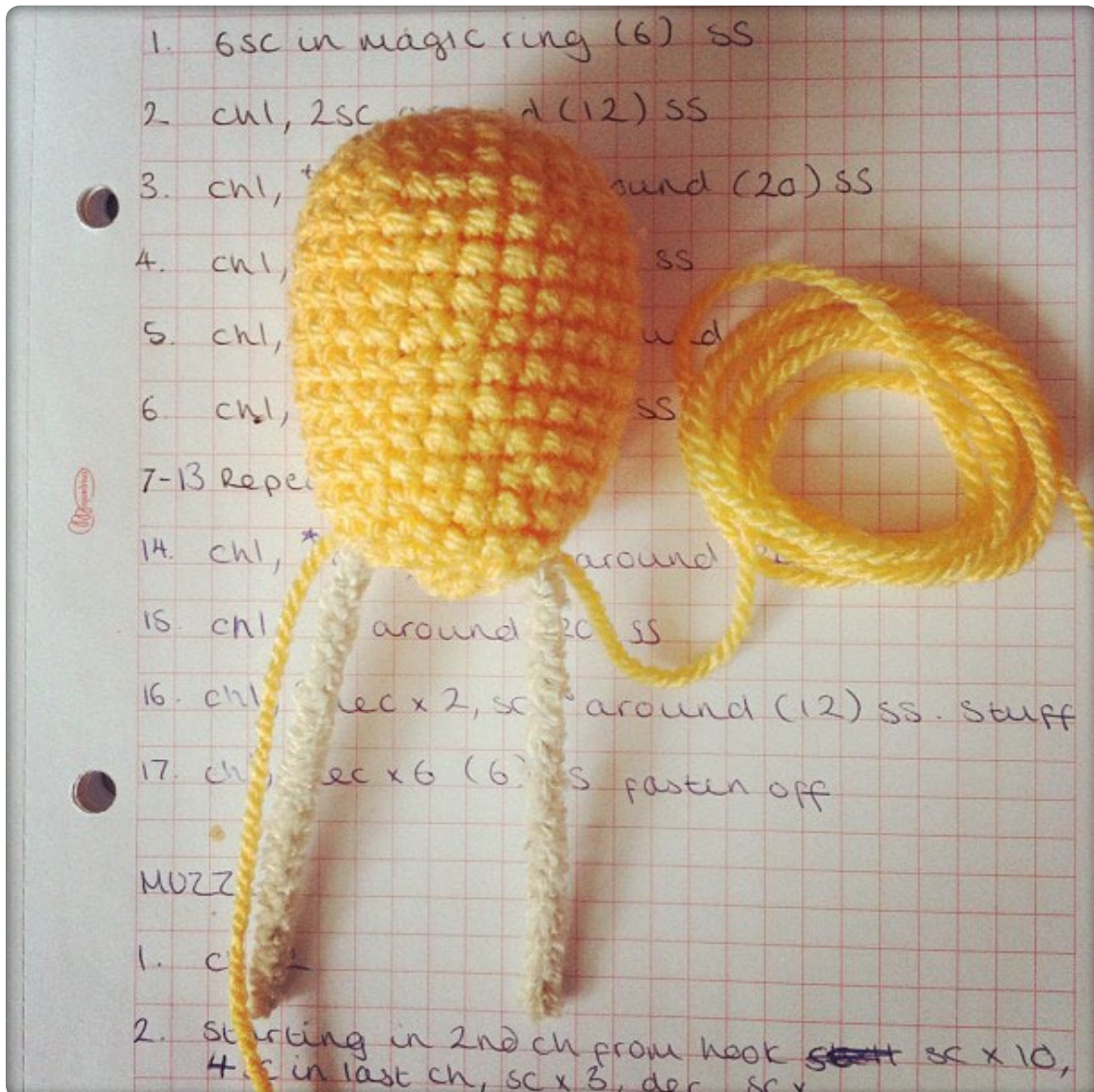
Ears

Make two:

R1. ch 3, 3 dc in first ch. *Fasten off with a long tail to sew to the head.*

Limbs

Thread two pipecleaners (as long as you like for mega posability) through the body to form the base of Jake's limbs. You'll probably need a wide-eyed yarn needle to help you with this, or you could do it before you stuff the body. The picture below shows one pipecleaner for the hind legs.





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Make four:

R 1. sc x 4 in a magic ring. (4)

R 2. In blo: sc x 4. (4)

R 3. sc in each sc and keep going until your piece is long enough to cover your pipecleaner limb.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail to sew to the body.

Tail

R1. ch 4, starting in 2nd chain from hook: sc x 3.

Fasten off with a long tail to sew to his behind.

Eyes

Cut circles of black felt and two slightly smaller circles of white felt and glue them together.

Glue the two eyes to the face, slipping the edge of the eye under the muzzle.

Cut a small oval for the nose and glue it on.

Now go rough-housing together.
